2. **Excursions marked by an asterisk * must be paid for in advance.** Bookings for these excursions remain provisional for up to fourteen days during which time full payment must be sent to Avanti Coach Travel, 26, Heath Way, Blofield, Norwich, NR13 4RS. A receipt will be sent to you by return. The booking will be cancelled after fourteen days if payment has not been received. Cheques for all excursions must be made payable to: ***“Avanti Coach Travel”***.
3. **The capital letter shown in brackets beside each excursion date indicates the pick-up time. Please refer to the timetable at the back of the brochure to match the letter with your pick-up point to find your pick-up time.**
4. If you cancel your excursion booking within the seven days prior to the date of travel, you will be required to pay the full fare costs. However, the fare cost can be transferred to a new future booking. **All refunds made in respect of cancellations by customers will be subject to a £2.00 administration charge.** There will be no refund made for tickets which we have already paid for on your behalf in respect of admission to an attraction during an excursion, unless someone else is able to take your place.

(A) Sunday 31st March

Mother's Day Tour - Burnham Deepdale Spring Market, Hunstanton & Norfolk Lavender

Enjoy the start of spring on the beautiful North Norfolk Coast. The Spring Market includes over 50 Norfolk artisans and producers in two large marquees, shops and stalls. The shops and Deepdale café of Dalegate Market will also be open. You will also enjoy some free time in Hunstanton before the final stop of the day at Norfolk Lavender.

Chartwell, Kent (National Trust)

Chartwell was the much-loved home of Sir Winston Churchill and his family and today all the rooms in the house are very much as they were when the family lived here. You will see photographs, paintings, books, newspapers and even some of Churchill's famous cigars. Churchill was not only a great statesman, he was also an exceptional writer and a very talented artist and during your visit you will see his studio where he created many of his works of art. Set in a peaceful, rural location in the Kent countryside, the gardens at Chartwell reflect Sir Winston's love of the landscape and nature and they include the lakes that he created, a delightful kitchen garden and the Marycot, a playhouse designed for his youngest daughter Mary. Your admission ticket gives you access to all areas of the house and grounds. National Trust members enjoy a discount of £14 off the price of the excursion.

(X) Thursday 16th May

Rhododendrons & Azaleas at Stody Lodge and visit to Sheringham

In May the extensive rhododendron and azalea gardens at Stody Lodge provide a spectacular display of colour. With a backdrop of magnificent mature trees, you will see the beautifully kept gardens and other spring flowers such as bluebells and lily-of-the-valley. A short woodland walk will take you to the exceptional two acre Japanese Water Garden. With more than 2000 plants, this is probably the largest single planting of vividly coloured azalea mollis in England. We make a morning visit to Sheringham en route to Stody.

The Cockney Matinee Show with Lunch

On board the Tereza-Joanne, Royal Docks, London

A delightful and warm-hearted afternoon of genuine Cockney entertainment starring Gordon Bennett (yes, that's his real name!) Without doubt the best solo Cockney entertainer working in the UK today, Gordon's performance is described as Chas & Dave meets Max Bygraves with a dash of Max Miller! He plays keyboard, ukulele and the Cockney Spoons and involves the audience in typical Cockney sing-a-longs. You can also expect plenty of Cockney humour, flag waving, dancing, Cockney Strolling and an Okey Cokey finale – because that's what it's all about.

Lunch is included, with a choice of chicken and chips or fish goujons and chips served in a basket before the first half of the show. The fully licensed bar is open throughout and you can also purchase a dessert from the trolley during the interval. The venue, the Tereza-Joanne, is a huge converted barge boat with level access that is permanently moored at the George V Dock. From your seat at the reserved banqueting tables you will get spectacular views over the water to the City of London skyline. We arrive at the Tereza-Joanne at 12 noon and depart shortly after 3:30 pm.

You may wish to take a trip on the Tour Bus which will enable you to see all the main attractions in the town as well as Anne Hathaway's Cottage at Shottery on the outskirts of Stratford. Along the way you will see the Royal Shakespeare Theatre, Holy Trinity Church where Shakespeare is buried and Stratford's two historic bridges.

Situated ten miles to the south of Bedford, Wrest Park's magnificent 90 acre gardens include many delightful statues, tranquil lakes and majestic woodlands. The grounds bear the mark of Capability Brown and following recent garden restoration work you can enjoy the vast and varied gardens to the full. Take a stroll beside Long Water to the beautiful domed Archer Pavilion, once the ultimate garden dining room, or discover how the house served as the country's original First World War convalescent home through diary entries and photographs. There are a number of lovely buildings to discover in the grounds. These include the Chinese Temple, the Bath House, the Orangery and Bowling Green House. In the ornamental Dairy you will see the garden sculpture gallery. The café is situated in the walled garden and provides light lunches and refreshments. There is level access to the café and Visitor Centre.

(D) Thursday 20th June

Bentley Priory Museum, near Bushey, North London

Bentley Priory Museum presents the fascinating story of the beautiful Grade II listed country house and its role as Headquarters of Fighter Command during the Battle of Britain. You can discover remarkable stories of leadership, courage and technology and how ultimately the Battle of Britain was won. During the visit explore the important stories of "The One", "The Few" and "The Many". "The One" - Air Chief Marshal Sir Hugh Dowding; "The Few" - the skillful and courageous airmen; "The Many" - the thousands of people on the ground involved in many different ways in supporting the airmen and in the planning and execution of the air operations.

Our visit will include a 10 minute film about Bentley Priory and how it operated during the war. Following the film there will be a guided tour of the museum that will give you detailed information about the many amazing exhibits that are on display and the history of the RAF's occupation of the property for many years after the war. Our visit will include the cost of lunch which will be either a sandwich, cake and tea or coffee or a jacket potato, cake and tea or coffee. There is a choice of fillings which you can choose from when you book.

The grounds at Bentley Priory include an Italian Garden with terrace where you can enjoy lunch - weather permitting!

**Thaxted & Cressing Temple Barns (including two-course lunch)
England's Vernacular Architecture**

A new tour in the company of an excellent Blue Badge Guide that includes a leisurely morning walking tour in the picture-postcard village of Thaxted in North Essex and an afternoon tour to visit the massive and beautiful Cressing Temple Barns near Braintree.

After morning coffee and biscuits, we set off to see the Vernacular architecture in Thaxted, i.e. buildings that were constructed in the local tradition using only locally available materials and skills. Thaxted has a number of these wonderful buildings and our guide will explain how they were built and the reason for their design. The walking tour will take in most of the village centre and our guide will be able to give you information on both the medieval buildings and the rest of the village in general. He/she will also relate great stories regarding Gustav Holst and the Red Vicar, who were both residents in the village. After our two-course lunch we visit the colossal Cressing Temple Barns that are so ancient that they were built when Genghis Khan and St Francis of Assisi were alive. There is also a Tudor walled garden to enjoy and time to visit the tearoom before we leave.

Admission to the show includes entrance to Sandringham Gardens, Museum and Church.

Waltham Abbey & Capel Manor Gardens

Situated on the borders of Essex, Hertfordshire and Greater London, Waltham Abbey is a traditional market town steeped in history with Royal connections and has a very impressive Abbey Church and gardens at its centre. The town's association with the monarchy include King Harrold, who founded the monastery here in the eleventh century, and Richard the Lionheart who granted its Market Charter. Waltham Abbey is part of the Epping Forest district, adjacent to the Lee Valley Country Park, and has many 16th century timber-framed buildings and a fine "Art Nouveau" Town Hall. In the town centre you will find a good blend of shops and cafes as well as the market which is held on Tuesday.

Your day will also include a visit to the beautiful 30 acre Capel Manor Gardens. This is Greater London's only specialist College of Horticulture and you will find many richly planted themed gardens, seven of which were designed by former students. Refreshments can be enjoyed in the Terrace Restaurant and the Hessayon Visitor Centre has a garden gift shop and plant sales area.

Buckingham Palace State Rooms & Queen Victoria Exhibition

The State Rooms at the Palace were designed for monarchs to receive, reward and entertain their subjects and to receive visiting dignitaries on State and ceremonial occasions. The State Rooms reflect the taste of King George IV, with many of the furnishings and works of art coming from Carlton House, The King's London home when he was Prince of Wales. However, the State Rooms are also furnished with many of the greatest treasures from the Royal Collection.

To celebrate the 200th anniversary of Queen Victoria's birth, a special exhibition, Queen Victoria's Palace, will tell the story of how the young queen transformed Buckingham Palace from a private house into a working royal residence. Together with Prince Albert, she made Buckingham Palace a rallying point for the nation, a powerful symbol of the British Monarchy, and a family home for their nine children.
